Temperature-Taking Exercise

2 We will be conducting our regular temperature-taking exercise on Friday 30 June. Indoor Sports Hall

Construction of the ISH has commenced and is expected to be completed by the 2nd quarter of 2018.

During the construction period, we will work with the contractor to accord top priority to the safety and well-being of our school community.

Dance-in-Curriculum

8 In Term 3, all Sec 1 students will attend dance lessons as part of the school's continuing effort to promote love for the Arts among our students. The programme is fully subsidised by the school and a certificate of attendance will be issued to all students who fulfil at least 90% of the overall attendance.
