## Your **overall** results matters!

**Overall Mark =**

**WA1 (15%) + WA2 (15%) + WA3 (15%)  
+ SA2 (55%)**

*Specific additional requirements for some subjects (eg Additional Mathematics)*

*ALL subjects are taken into account during streaming.*

## NOTE:

- There are additional criteria for subjects such as Additional Maths, Pure Sciences, Pure Geography, etc.
- Students who are given **Pure Science** combinations (E1 & E2) must pass all Pure Sciences at Sec 3. Otherwise, they will be asked to drop a pure science or switch to a combined science.
- There is also **no** triple science combination at JC.
- Students who are offered **8 subject combinations (E1)** will need to stay back on some days after normal curriculum hours. They will also have fewer periods for EL, Math, A Math etc.

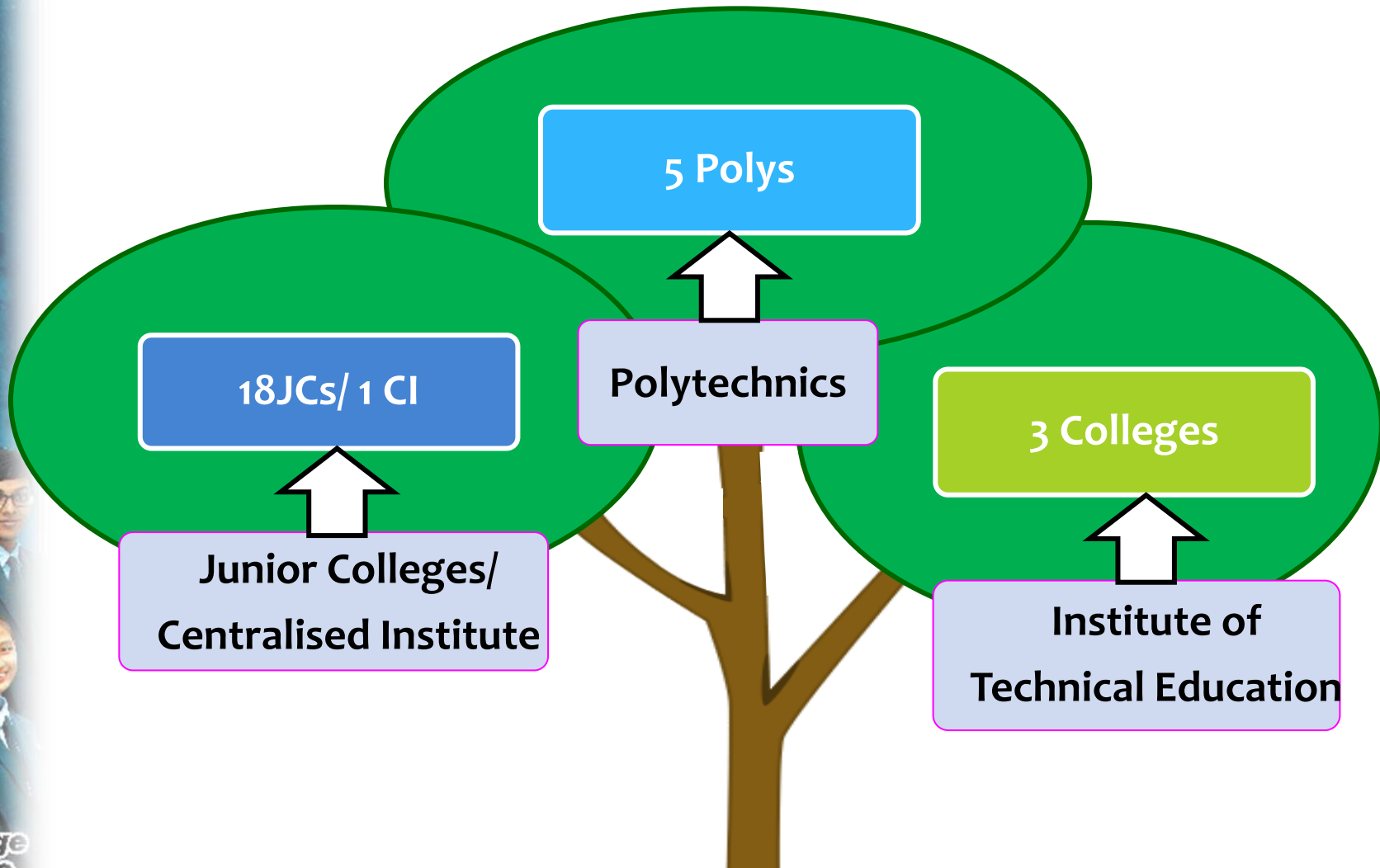

# Junior Colleges / Centralised Institute

- Pre-University Education prepares students for the **GCE A-Level examination** at the end of the **2-year** Junior College or **3-year** Centralised Institute course.

## JC Entry Requirements

- JC
- $L1 + R5 \leq 20 \text{ pts}^*$
- Plus
  - $EL \leq C6$
  - $\text{Math} \leq D7$  and  $MT \leq D7$  or a pass for syllabus B
- R5 must include
  - Humanities
  - Math / Science

- MI
- $L1 + R4 \leq 20 \text{ pts}^*$
- Plus
  - $EL \leq C6$
  - $\text{Math} \leq D7$  and  $MT \leq D7$  or a pass for syllabus B
- R4 must include
  - 2 subjects from Humanities / Math / Science

\* Before including CCA Bonus points



# CCA Bonus Points

- For admission to JCs/Polys/ITE
- Students with an 'Excellent' grade in CCA enjoy 2 bonus points, while those with a 'Good' grade enjoy 1 bonus point.
- Cannot be used to meet minimum entry requirement.

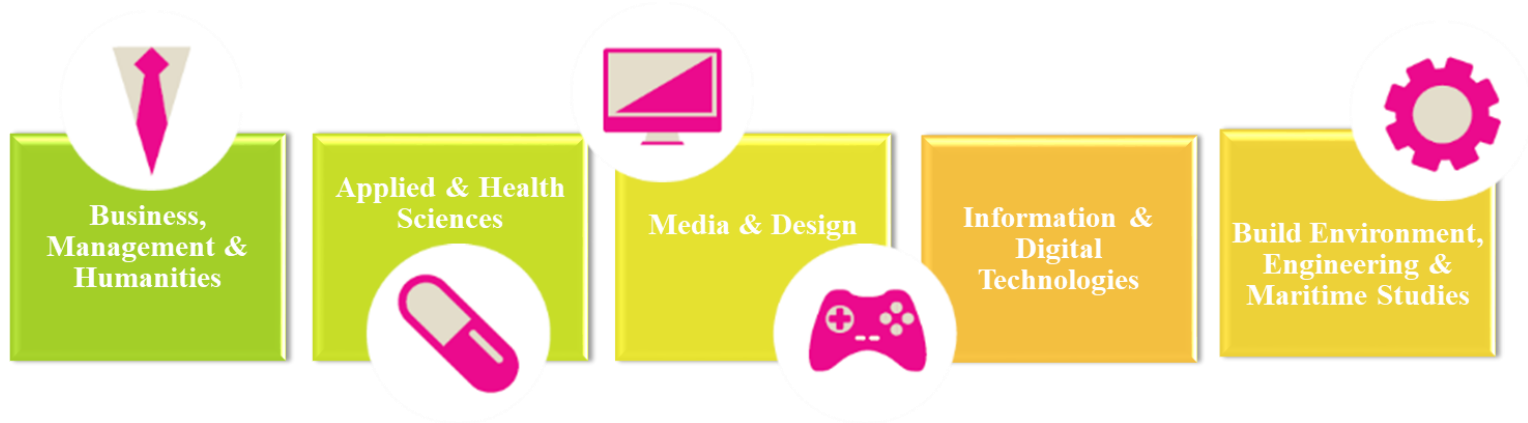

# Polytechnic Entry requirements

- **EL + 2 Relevant Subjects (R2) + 2 Best Subjects (B2)  $\leq$  26 \***
  - Technology Courses R2
    - Math  $\leq$  C6
    - Science  $\leq$  C6
  - Non-Technology Courses R2
    - Math  $\leq$  C6
    - Humanities  $\leq$  C6
- **Meet Minimum Entry Requirements (MER)**
- CCA Bonus Points are included during course placement exercise

Open to GCE 'O' Level holders, JAE begins the same day as the release of the GCE "O" Level results.

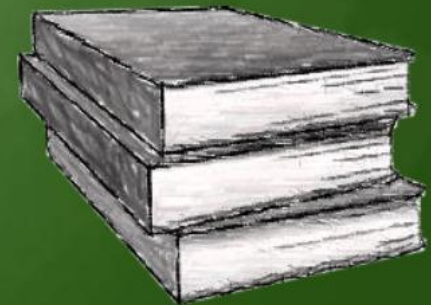
## Importance of Subjects Awareness
