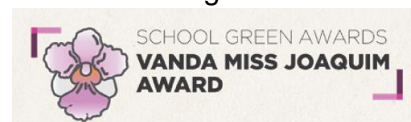
### Early Dismissal Due to National Examination - 12<sup>th</sup> Sep (Tue) & 20<sup>th</sup> Sep (Wed)

6 To allow students time to prepare for the End-of-Year Examinations, all students will stand down from CCAs from **Tue, 12 Sep** onwards. CCA Training for Sec 1 - 3 will resume after the End of Year Examinations on **Thu, 19 Oct**.

7 Please also note that CCA sessions on **19, 25 and 26 Oct** will take place from 0730 – 1300h; and there will be NO afternoon training sessions for these weeks.

## Term 4 Week 2 Student Well-being Week

8 Term 4 can be a very stressful period for students just before the End-of-Year exam. In order to help students better manage their anxiety, the school will be organising small activities for student to destress just before the exams. This include participating in some team-building games during CCE lessons, writing well-wishes for one another during Form Teacher period, dedicating songs to one another during break time and enjoying a small sweet treat during PRA1SE\* on Friday. Tips on how to destress during this stressful period will also be shared during assembly. (\* PRA1SE – Pause and Reflect to Affirm ONE School Experience)

9 Please note that Term 4 Week 2, Friday, 22 September 2023 will follow an odd week's Friday Timetable. Students will be required to be physically present in school for lessons. It is not a home-based learning day.

## End-of-Year Examination

10 The End-of-Year Examination begins in Term 4 Week 3 for Secondary 1 to 3 students. The examination timetable has been given to students and it is also available on the school website.

11 Students should refer to the rules and regulations for the examination in the Student Handbook. Students must inform their Form Teachers if they are absent from the exam and submit a Medical Certificate when they return to school. Students may leave the school after completing their exam for the day.

12 Students are not required to attend school on 12 Oct and 13 Oct which are the school's Marking Day, as well as 20 Oct, Results Processing Day.

13 To nurture the Joy of Learning in Deyians, students will participate in a variety of specially planned programmes after their End-of-Year Examination. 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## Sec 2 Streaming Exercise - 20-30 Oct

14 The school will be conducting the Sec 2 Streaming Exercise after the End-of-Year Examination. This is an important exercise as it will determine the subject combination that your child/ward will take next year when promoted to Sec 3. At the briefing for parents/guardians and students on 14 April, we explained the criteria that we will be using for streaming and the subject combinations that will be offered in 2024. 15 We will be using a Google Form to conduct the streaming exercise. Your child/ward will need to log into his/her ICON email account to select his/her preferred subject combinations. The Google Form will be available for submission from **Friday, 20 October to Monday, 30 October**. Please review with your child/ward his/her academic performance, aptitude and career aspirations to help him/her decide his/her subject combination choices. Your child/ward will not be able to access the Google Form after **30 October**. For students who do not indicate their choices, the school will stream them according to their overall results.

16 Do note that the actual number of subject combinations that will finally be offered will depend on a number of factors, such as the number of students who apply for and are eligible for the various subject combinations.

## Last Day of School - 27 Oct Fri / Holiday Assignments

18 Please note that Friday 27 Oct is the last day of school for the year. To help your child/ward revise key topics and prepare for the following year, subject teachers may identify some assignments to be done in November-December. We appreciate your support in ensuring that your child/ward completes the assignments in stages over the holidays so that he/she will have sufficient time to rest before school reopens. However, a number of activities will continue to take place until 17 Nov, e.g. Student Leadership training, CCA practice and enrichment activities. The respective teachers-in-charge of these activities will be informing you of the schedule and your child's/ward's commitment through Parents Gateway.

Please submit your application form together with the supporting documents to the General Office by 13 October 2023 to prevent unnecessary delay in the issue of textbooks and uniforms.
